
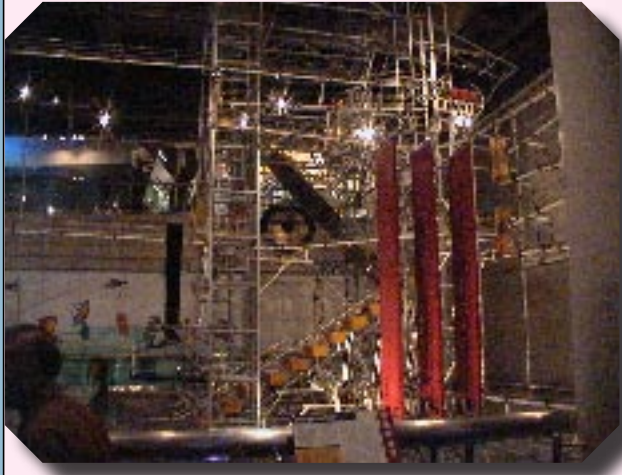


Hong Kong Trip
