At school, I would be more attentive in all my lessons and would be a more active participant in the various learning tasks. I would behave well : be polite to everybody, be honest and humble. I would also be punctual, follow school rules and regulations, submit my homework on time and do my best to have a better relationship with teachers, classmates and others. I would work harder with my studies so that I could get better results. I would share my joy and sorrow with my classmates and invite them to my small but cozy home to meet with my family, play with my brother and have meals with us.

I wish I could have the chance to be a perfect girl for my parents, a supportive sister for my brother and a good student for my teachers. However, it was merely a fake dream. I hereby heartily plead you to cherish your life, always live in the moment and be the best of yourself every day.
