Fun with English Idioms Let's move on to 'Colours --- black and blue'

Wonderland

black and blue

瘀傷

having a dark mark on the skin due to an accident or being hit

Example: My ankle is black and blue because I fell and got it twisted when I was jogging this morning.

black out

進入黑暗

(for the lights) to go out

Example: All the lights of the building blacked out as there was a breakdown in the electricity supply.

black sheep

害群之馬

a person who is a disgrace to the group

Example: Chris was the black sheep of the class as he often caused disturbances.

once in a blue moon 非常罕見

very seldom

Example: Husband and wife who are about the same age argue only once in a blue moon and they can maintain an intimate relationship easily.

blue in the face

臉上發紫

very angry

Example: Jane argued with James about the project until she was blue in the face.

out of the blue

出乎意料

suddenly and without warning

Example: The director cut down the cost of my project out of the blue.
